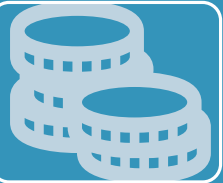


WFO WITH YOUNG FARMERS

#### **SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship consists of exemption from the payment of the tuition fee for a value of EUR 8,500 (eight thousand five hundred)

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

In order to participate to the selection procedure for this scholarship, candidates need to satisfy the following:

- Being a farmer;
- Age under 35;
- Official residence in a developing country;
- Eligible 4 years university degree;
- Knowledge of English with a minimum level of B2;
- Professional motivation for attending this course.



#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- Copy of an identity document (passport or National ID Card where applicable);
- Copy of academic transcripts with details of exams, grades and academic credits;

- Motivation letter explaining the applicant's personal motivation for attending the Master of Law (LL.M.) in Food Law.
