Graduate young farmers, aged under 35 and coming from developing countries



SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship consists of exemption from the payment of the tuition fee for a value of EUR 8,500 (eight thousand five hundred).



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In order to participate to the selection procedure for this scholarship, candidates need to satisfy the following:

- Being a farmer.
- Age under 35.
- Official residence in a developing country.
- Eligible 4 years university degree.
- Knowledge of English with a minimum level of B2.
- Professional motivation for attending this course.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applicants need to send no later than November 6th to secretariat@wfo-oma.org the following documents:

- Copy of an identity document (passport or National ID Card where applicable);
- Copy of academic transcripts with details of exams, grades and academic credits;
- Curriculum vitae et studiorum (CV);
- Motivation letter explaining the applicant's personal motivation for attending the Master of Law (LL.M.) in Food Law.
